**ANGLO-SUISSE REPORTS SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF SIX-WELL
WEST DELTA DRILLING PROGRAM ON GOM SHELF**

HOUSTON (July 28, 2008) – Anglo-Suisse Offshore Partners, LLC (ASOP), (www.anglosuisse.com) today announced the completion of a six-well drilling program in its shelf acreage in the West Delta area of central Gulf of Mexico. Total net production from the wells has added some 40 percent to ASOP’s net daily production. Eighty percent of the new production is oil.

Anglo-Suisse Offshore Partners (ASOP) is a joint venture between Anglo-Suisse Investments, a Houston based exploration and production company, and ArcLight Capital Partners, a private equity firm headquartered in Boston. ASOP is operator and holds 100 percent of the working interest in the wells.

All six wells, which were drilled with the Pride New Mexico mat jack-up rig, encountered commercial quantities of oil and natural gas. Specifically, they include: West Delta 27 AH9-ST2, West Delta 27 AH8-ST2, West Delta 29 #37, West Delta 28 #16, West Delta 27 #12, and West Delta 29 #26.

ASOP acquired the West Delta properties from Chevron in July 2004. According to CEO and co-founder John Sherwood, “This drilling program represents the company’s continued development of the company’s Gulf of Mexico properties. We intend to undertake a new drilling program in the West Delta area later in 2008,” he added.
